Index Name: Kellgren Lawrence

Hand OA radiological index

Generalities:

Radiographs for hand OA could be either plain or digitalized images. Anteroposterior views of both hands on the same film are used.

Target population:

Patients with hand osteoarthritis

Method of use:

Radiological features of the Kellgren and Lawrence grading system of OA: Scoring each of the 30 joints from 0 to 4 according to the presence of osteophytes and joint space narrowing (subsequent suggestions by Spector and Lane).

Grade 0: none (no features)

Grade 1: doubtful OA (Osteophyte with doubtful significance)

Grade 2: minimal OA(Definite osteophyte, unpaired joint space)

Grade 3: moderate OA (Moderate diminution of joint space)

Grade 4: severe OA (Joint space greatly impaired with sclerosis of sub-chondral bone)
